MATERIAL USED

Scissors
Silk paper or stabilizer (follow the manufacturer's instructions).

STITCHES USED

Please refer to the sketch to reference the stitches used.
Use one strand of Anchor tapisserie wool.

INSTRUCTIONS

You can apply this design on a wool sweater or any other knitted garment you want.

Print the pattern.

Transfer the pattern to the sweater. You can use a silk paper or a stabilizer for embroidery. Trace the pattern onto silk paper, pin the paper to the fabric, and stitch right through the paper and the fabric together, following the pattern markings. Avoid over-tightening the stitches. If you use an stabilizer, follow the instructions indicated by the manufacturer.

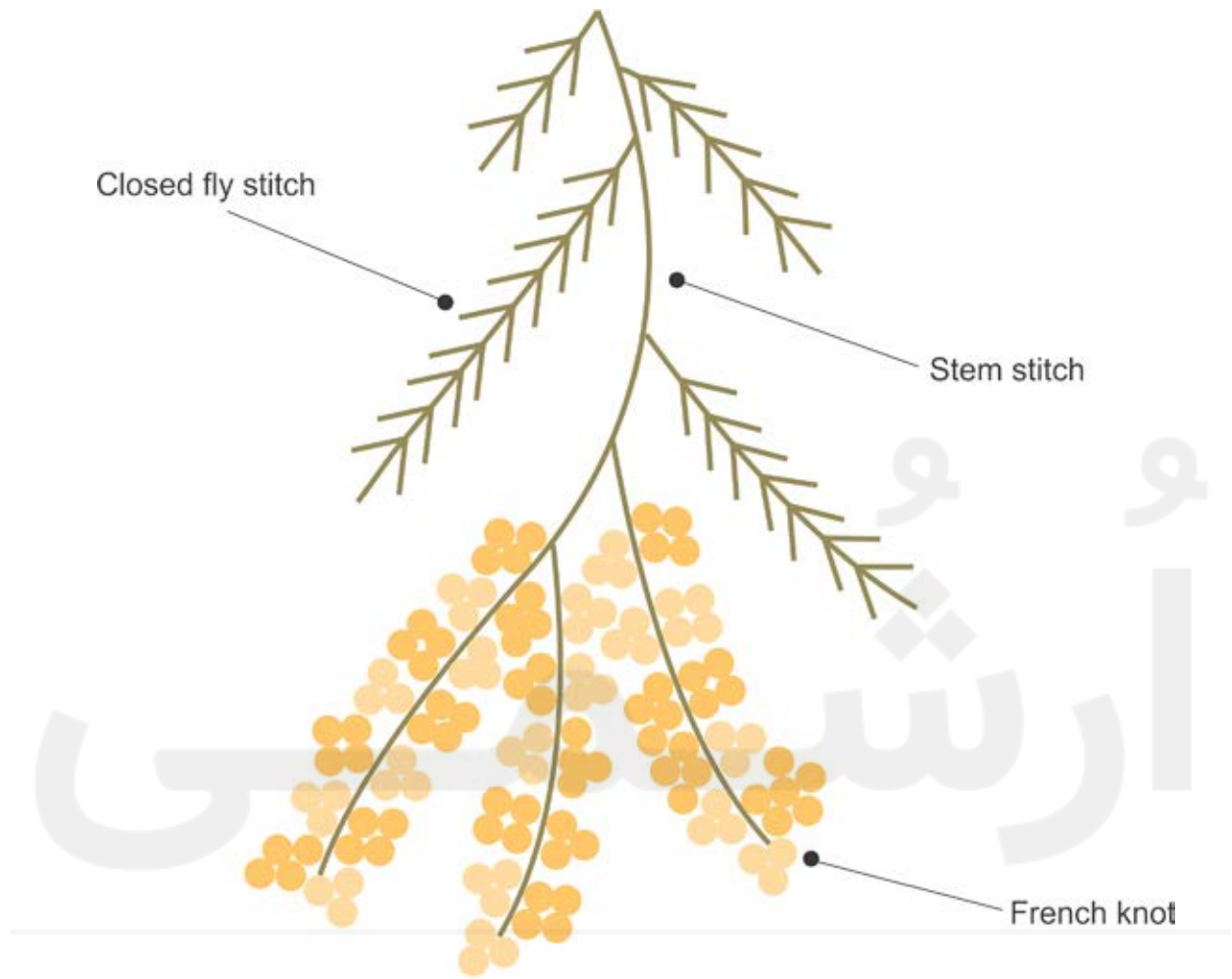
Embroider stems with stem stitch.

Embroider the branches with closed fly stitch.

Remove the silk paper with care.

Finally, embroider flowers with french knot stitch. The French knot can be damaged when removing the silk paper, so it is preferable to remove it first and do it later.

Tip: placing this type of fabric in a hoop can stretch the knitted material and misshape it, so if possible, work without a hoop.
